

10. Covid-19

In order to protect people exposed to SARS-CoV-2, the Local Health Agency (ASL) makes available a contact tracing service that provides information to affected people: a healthcare professional calls the patients to ask them about their health status and explain safe behaviours and rules. If you cannot leave your home to attend a medical consultation because of an alleged or proven SARS-CoV-2 infection, you can avail yourself of USCA (Continuity of care Special Units “Unità Speciali di Continuità Assistenziale”), a team of healthcare professionals specialized in COVID-19.

In case of flu-like symptoms (cough, sore throat, fever, cold), you should contact your referring doctor (general practitioner/paediatrician, out-of-hours doctor or STP clinic's doctor). Then, he will activate the most appropriate programme.

Vaccinations against Sars Cov-2/COVID-19

Even if you are not registered in the SSN, you can access anti-Sars Cov2 vaccinations. You can contact your referring doctor (general practitioner/paediatrician, out-of-hours doctor or STP clinic's doctor) for further information on the procedures.
